French Braid Quilt

Create this amazing quilt top using strips of multiple fabrics in columns that combine for a dramatic geometric statement. The quilt is made with 4 matching columns with contrasting borders. This is easier than it looks, just a strip piecing method that adds to the center square. The class fee is \$40.00 for 5 1/2 hours of class time. Students are required to purchase the book French Braid Quilts by Jean Hardy Miller. A supply list will be provided prior to class. Come in early for help with fabric selections.
